4 Water Event

Local and federal water pollution restrictions increase forcing industries to release less pollutants into the water supply.



1 Water Event
Interrupt

Shipping technology advances. Solar powered ships use 80% less fossil fuel, dramatically reducing water pollution.



A Draw

Choose a player. That player draws two cards. Discard down to the hand limit if necessary.

A Discard

Choose a player other than yourself. That player must discard two cards, randomly chosen by you, to the discard pile.
